Alcohol Service at Everglades

At Everglades Country Club, we're all about creating a safe, relaxed, and enjoyable environment for our members, guests, and staff. As a proud part of the Woy Woy community, we encourage everyone to enjoy themselves while looking out for one another.

We take the responsible service of alcohol seriously and follow all requirements under the *Liquor Act 2007 (NSW)*. This means we do not serve alcohol to anyone under 18 or to anyone who is intoxicated.

How We Support Responsible Service

To help keep our club safe and welcoming for everyone, we:

- May ask for valid ID at any time to confirm age or identity
- Do not allow entry to anyone who appears intoxicated
- Do not serve alcohol to anyone under 18
- Do not serve alcohol to anyone who is intoxicated
- Will stop service and may ask a patron to leave if they become intoxicated
- Display clear signage about alcohol service and legal requirements throughout the Club
- Expect all patrons to behave respectfully — aggressive, quarrelsome, or inappropriate behaviour isn't accepted
- Ensure all staff serving alcohol hold a current RSA (Responsible Service of Alcohol) competency card
